Asset Details

- 1. **Building** rats and snakes can enter huts. Hut #1 (left most) needs securing from snakes. Hut #3 needs security door.
- 2. **Documentation** Need SOPs, schedules, shared contact list
- Inventory Parts Tool shed needs streamlining. Long pipes storage difficult to unload & disinfect. Purchased Schedule 80 inventory.
- 4. **Inventory Tools** waterboard should own its own common tools
- 5. **Blow Offs** 5 are brittle, border ones unsecured
- 6. **Valves** 15 are very old, some turn but do not seal! Unable to shut off a branch causes the Main line to be shut off for days!
- 7. **Price Line** need securing and possibly covering
- 8. **Pipes To/From Meter** polypipe brittle, needs replacing
- 9. **Seepage** 1227 gallons per day (5.3 inches/day Steel Tank)
- 10. Tank Steel Liner need to replace 2008 liner. Pics show rust on walls.
- 11. **Roads** rocky, need berms, Stafford crossing floods easily
- 12. Water Condition water filter community center 2024, high coliform in Summer so need upgraded procedures
- 13. **Volunteers** need training schedule and regimen
- 14. Water Manager replacement happens March 2025

Recent Asset Improvements (March to May 2024)

- 1. Mooney well gate valve and nipple
- 2. Smoketree branch 2" gate valve and blow-off
- 3. Smoketree 3" main gate valve
- 4. Canebrake/Smoketree main 3" gate valve
- 5. Automation Tank Water Level Reading
- 6. Creek Crossing Culverts and Riprap
- 7. PVC Parts Inventory created and restocked

Vendor Clarify - SDRMA (liability insurance)

SDRMA was contacted to inquire if CCWD is covered when using heavy equipment on personal property.

Statement of Operations to Confirm with SDRMA:

- We can operate the heavy equipment within our District Boundary.
- We can charge a fee for those services to the patrons that have dwellings in our district.
- We are covered provided we do NOT contract out for others to do the work. Either our volunteer staff or board members are allowed to operate the equipment who are both members of our District.

SDRMA reply:

Based on the description of the operations, we do not see any coverage issues. Please keep in mind that each individual claim can be unique and will be investigated and evaluated based on how it is filed.

If you are unsure about the operations that the district can conduct, we recommend that you check with the district's legal counsel and also possibly the LAFCO. We are not able to give legal advice on what the district can do, only how coverage would apply. For example if you are operating in a capacity that the state says you are not able and there is a fine, we would not cover any fines or penalties that the district is subject to.

Summary: We are covered to provide a Heavy Equipment Service to residents on their personal property provided it's within our District Boundary and we only perform the service with employees or volunteers of CCWD (not contracted out).
