I would like to suggest that one of the five Board members becomes knowledgeable with regards to the content of the “By-Laws” and the “Rules and Regulations”. This board member could then speak with some authority as to what they say during a meeting when a question arises.

No where in the By-Laws or Rules and Regs does it say that the district is “to Maintain Roads” or “to provide a service for heavy equipment for property owners”.

The sole purpose of this district is to provide water to its customers. I do think you need to reconsider your ideas about not providing water for fire prevention. The district does have qualified fire hydrants and the Fire Chief can be contacted when a new dwelling is being built for permit review. It has been done in the past and will probably be done in the future. Just because you have been delayed in the installation of a much needed second storage tank you shouldn't downplay the desirability this community has for extra storage no matter what the usage for that added storage is.

There is also a section in the “Rules and Regs” that states the districts liability or culpability in leaks on private property.
